Anyone responsible for the water quality, record keeping, chemical storage and general upkeep of a public swimming pool or spa in the state of Oregon. This includes pools and spas affiliated with apartments, condos, schools, recreational facilities and travelers' accommodations.

What will you gain?

Participants will leave the conference better able to:

- Calculate water volume and turnover times
- Understand basic filtration systems
- Test pool chemistry
- Determine corrective action needed
- Correct basic water chemistry imbalances
- Understand closure criteria: rules & safety
- Relate water chemistry to pool equipment durability and swimmer safety
- What is the inspector looking for and how to be ready anytime
- Know how to deal with fecal accidents in pools
- Review state & federal rule changes
- Keep legal records: this is your protection
- Confidently maintain a safe public pool
